Exhibit proposals for the following year are welcomed between February and March. Exhibit proposals for 2025 are due by midnight on Sunday March 31, 2024

Proposals will be juried, and applicants notified by early May. There is no fee to apply. Each applicant may only propose one exhibit.

The jury is composed of members of the Public Gallery Program's Curation Committee, a committee of staff, artists, curators, university faculty, art collectors, and local creatives.

### **Eligibility:**

- All mediums will be accepted
- Artists over 18 years of age are eligible to apply, Artists under 18 must apply with a sponsoring adult as the primary applicant.
- Artwork must be original
- Incomplete applications will not be considered
- Applications received after the due date will not be considered

#### **Application Process**

Interested artists and curators should complete the form below.\* Applications may be submitted for an individual artist, artist group, or a curated exhibition. If applying as an artist pair or group, please only submit one application for the proposed exhibit.

### \_Huron Mountain Club Gallery:

A community art gallery that features locally curated collective displays, local and emerging artists, and educational exhibits. Artist is responsible for the exhibit installation.

- The HMC is on the main floor of the Peter White Public Library.
- This gallery aims to host exhibits featuring community-oriented artwork and displays. This space provides a space for local curators to display collections of artworks of any level or medium and a platform for local and emerging artists to share their work. The gallery also serves as a valuable educational resource by offering a large venue for travelling or locally curated culture and heritage exhibits.
- The HMC Gallery has two distinct spaces allowing for smaller, side-by-side exhibits or one large exhibit.

### Deo Gallery:

A fine art gallery that features notable works of all mediums. Exhibit installation assistance provided by a Gallery Technician

- The Deo is in the City Arts and Culture Center, located on the lower level of the Peter White Public Library.
- This gallery aims to host exhibits featuring artwork created for its aesthetic and intellectual content. The artists and curators shown in this space should be highly skilled and experienced artists in their chosen medium.
- Applicants are expected to share their Artist CV and have a well-developed exhibit statement describing the works, artistic process, inspiration, and intention.
